A study of the software needed to communicate between the 3D printer and computer will follow next. After students learn the fundamentals of printing pre-designed 3D objects, they will practice designing objects using basic geometric shapes and other software tools. Students will work directly with a 3D printer connected to a personally owned computer or to a computer provided by the College. At the end of the camp, students will take their 3D printer home with them along with any software loaded onto their personally owned computer. Each student will also go home with a memory stick containing the software used at the camp. Students will be provided with a printing material called PLA for printing 3D objects which is biodegradable and an environmentally friendly plastic.
